## September 11, 2024

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Supervisor Jock. All Town Council members were present with the exception of Mike Kelley.

- I. **Minutes** Erin motions to accept the minutes from the previous meeting as read by the clerk. Motion is seconded by Sarah. All voted "Aye", motion carried.
- II. Darrin Jock addresses Board Highway issues regarding a ditch that is not draining at 438 Scanlon Road. Water is backing up on his property. Highway Superintendent will send employees out with a transit and measure the area. Question regarding whether it's in the town's right of way.
- III. **Bombay Fire Department** Secretary Tasha on behalf of BFD, requests a 2-4% increase in the 2025 budget.
- IV. Highway Report
  - Paving done at Sand/salt storage building
  - Some electrical at building is not working. S&L is supposed to come back
  - Salt needs to be put up
  - FEMA meetings
  - Met with NYPA about road damage (Cold Springs, Irish Ridge, Cotter, Scanlon, River, Quain, Regan Flats, Kibbie)
  - Hired a full-time laborer
  - 2020 Silverado needs warranty work, leaking gas
  - Retaining wall for Quain Road bridge has been supported.
- V. **Concrete Culverts** Don motions to obtain proposals from contractors for culvert work on Cold Springs and Scanlon Road. Motion is seconded by Erin, all voted "Aye", motion carried.
- VI. **Truck for Park** Salmon River has a small bus that will be up for auction. Chris will get more details.
- VII. Community Center Boiler Needs replacing.
- VIII. **NYSERDA Grant** Chris applied for a grant up to \$20,000 to replace heating system in Community Center. AEDA is assisting with options.
- IX. **Foreclosure Property** Brown property pulled from auction. It will be back in the auction in the Spring. Could be bought directly from John Brown.
- X. **Lighting Update** Still waiting on National Grid to move forward with adding more streetlights.
