

Meeting of the Bombay Town Board

January 14, 2026

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Supervisor Jock. Council members present were Mike Kelley and Jenelle Niles. Councilmembers Erin Gray and Sarah Devlin were absent. Patrick Mayer, Superintendent of Highways was also present.

- I. **Minutes** – Mike motions to accept the minutes from the previous meeting as read by the clerk, seconded by Chris. All voted “Aye”, motion carried.
- II. **Town Board Appointments** – Motioned by Mike, seconded by Jenelle. All voted “Aye”, motion carried.

- III. **FEMA-** Multiple projects have closed and payment is expected. Quain Road bridge slope is still being discussed. This slope needs a retaining wall by the bridge.
- IV. **Ballot Certification** – the following positions are set to appear on the 2026 General Election ballot:

 - Highway Superintendent
 - Town Justice (Smith)
- V. **Solid Waste Management** – There is an increase in fees for 2026 - \$20/ton extra.
- VI. **Tisdell Associates** – Mike motions to sign a short form engineering agreement with Tisdell for landfill monitoring in the amount of \$1500.00, seconded by Jenelle. All voted “Aye”, motion carried.

- VII. **Lantry Road Request** – NYSDOT sent a letter stating that they received our request to do a speed study on Lantry Road in hopes of lowering the speed limit. They are behind schedule and are planning to come in the spring.
- VIII. **Ft. Covington Senior Center** – In response to the center’s request for more support, Mike motions to allocate \$4500 instead of \$4000 for center support in 2026. Motion is seconded by Jenelle. All voted “Aye”, motion carried.
- VI. **Highway Report** –
- 2013 Truck caught fire (hydraulic hose on exhaust) and was extinguished
 - Monthly mileage and gas report submitted
 - Keeping up with snow removal
 - Large amount of garbage picked up on Irish Ridge Rd, DEC was contacted.
